Responsibilities

Attend the following online team meetings:

- Daily check-ins with your Lead Counselor as the camp progresses
- Debrief session after your commitment to the camp is over
- Online training session

Log in as a counselor during camp hours:

- Maintain a presence on our servers
 - Sign up for several 2-3 hr Kid's Club shifts per week (subject to change based on programs being offered) OR
 - Help run our affiliate and summer camps by working all 5 shifts in a camp
 - While on shift, be logged into a voice chat client with fellow counselors

- Be a mentor and guide for campers
 - Guide new campers through basic skills and answer their questions
 - Encourage campers to work together
 - Challenge campers who are looking for new things to do
 - Support campers who are having difficulties
 - Inspire campers with your own creations
 - Foster a sense of collaboration and community
- Support the Lead Counselors in designing and facilitating in-game special events such as games and building challenges
- Report griefing or technical issues to Lead Counselors
- Actively participate in your team's online collaboration space

Technical Requirements

- Have your own paid Minecraft account
- Access to a computer that has and supports the latest version of Minecraft
- Access to stable Internet with the bandwidth needed to support playing Minecraft
- Working microphone or headset and voice chat client

- Have expertise and passion for Minecraft and able to help inspire and support kids in learning how to level up their own expertise
- Experience in online multiplayer Minecraft
- Willingness to teach and be a mentor to others
- Have worked with kids age 9-13 in the past, or would like to learn how to
